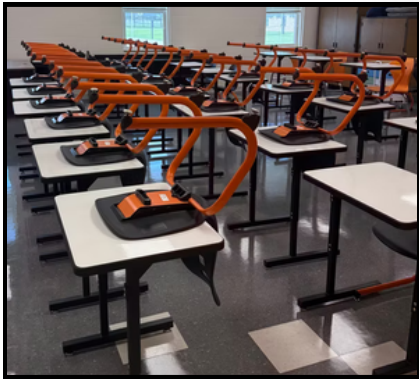




Physical Plant and Equipment Levy

September 9, 2025



On **Tuesday, September 9, 2025**, residents of the West Delaware County Community School District will consider renewing the district's **Physical Plant and Equipment Levy (PPEL)**.

If the voted PPEL is not renewed, the district will need to use general funds or state sales tax revenue to address the needs previously covered by the levy. This would delay other projects or could result in budget cuts.

More than 85% of Iowa school districts rely on a voted PPEL.

THIS IS NOT A NEW LEVY,

but an extension of what's been in place at West Delaware CCSD for many years. The district receives approximately \$510,000 annually from its voted PPEL. In the past, these funds have been used to:



Enhance safety and security



Maintain HVAC systems



Repair and replace roofs



Expand technology for students



Purchase school buses and vans



Improve activity facilities



Replace classroom furniture



Upgrade music equipment



Install new signs and branding

Voters are being asked to consider extending the levy through 2036 at the existing rate of **\$0.67 per \$1,000** of taxable property value. A renewed PPEL on September 9 **WILL NOT** increase tax rates.
